OVERVIEW: ESS

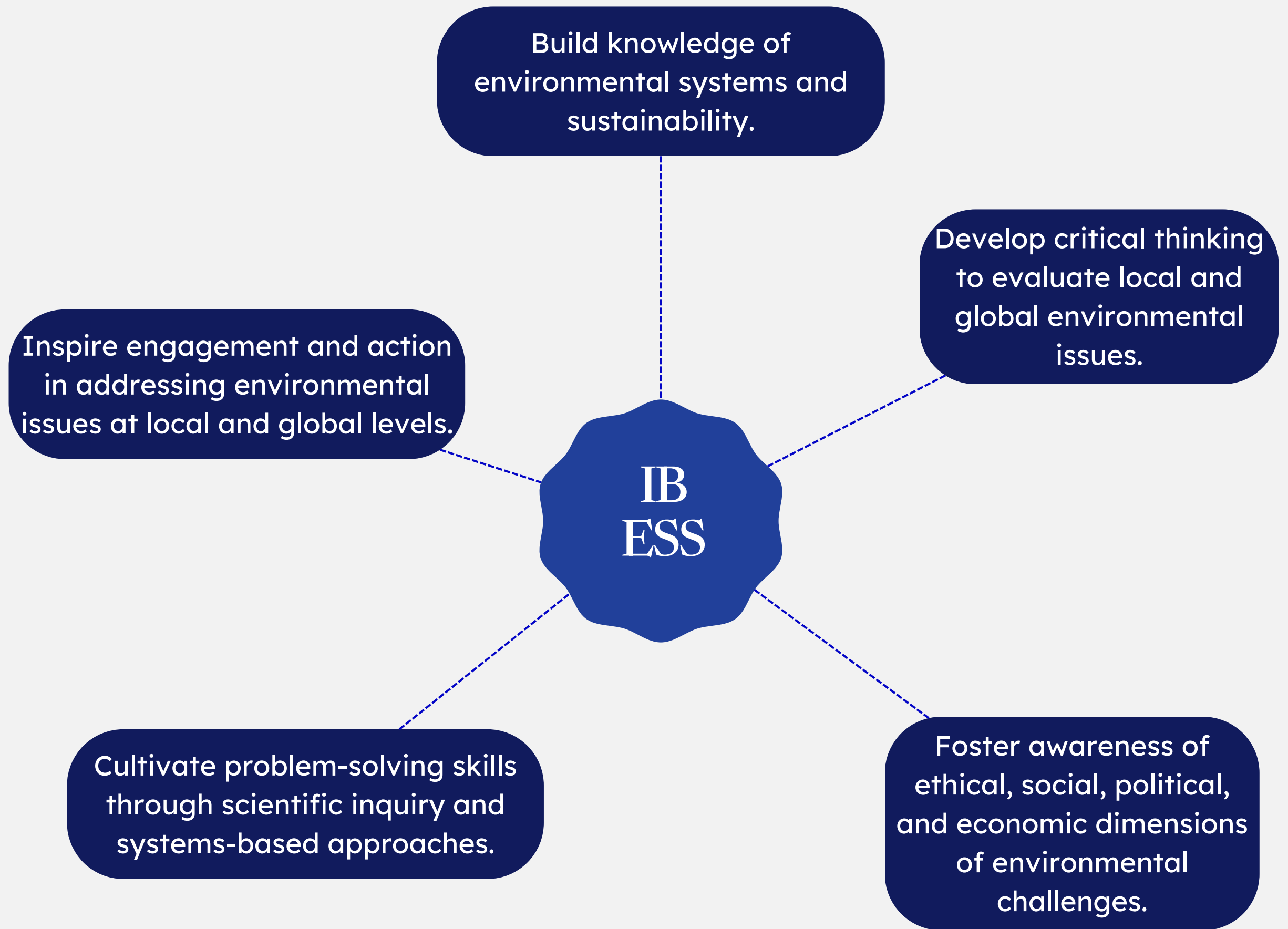
IB Environmental Systems and Societies (ESS) is an interdisciplinary course that explores environmental issues through a blend of science and social studies.

COURSE AIMS

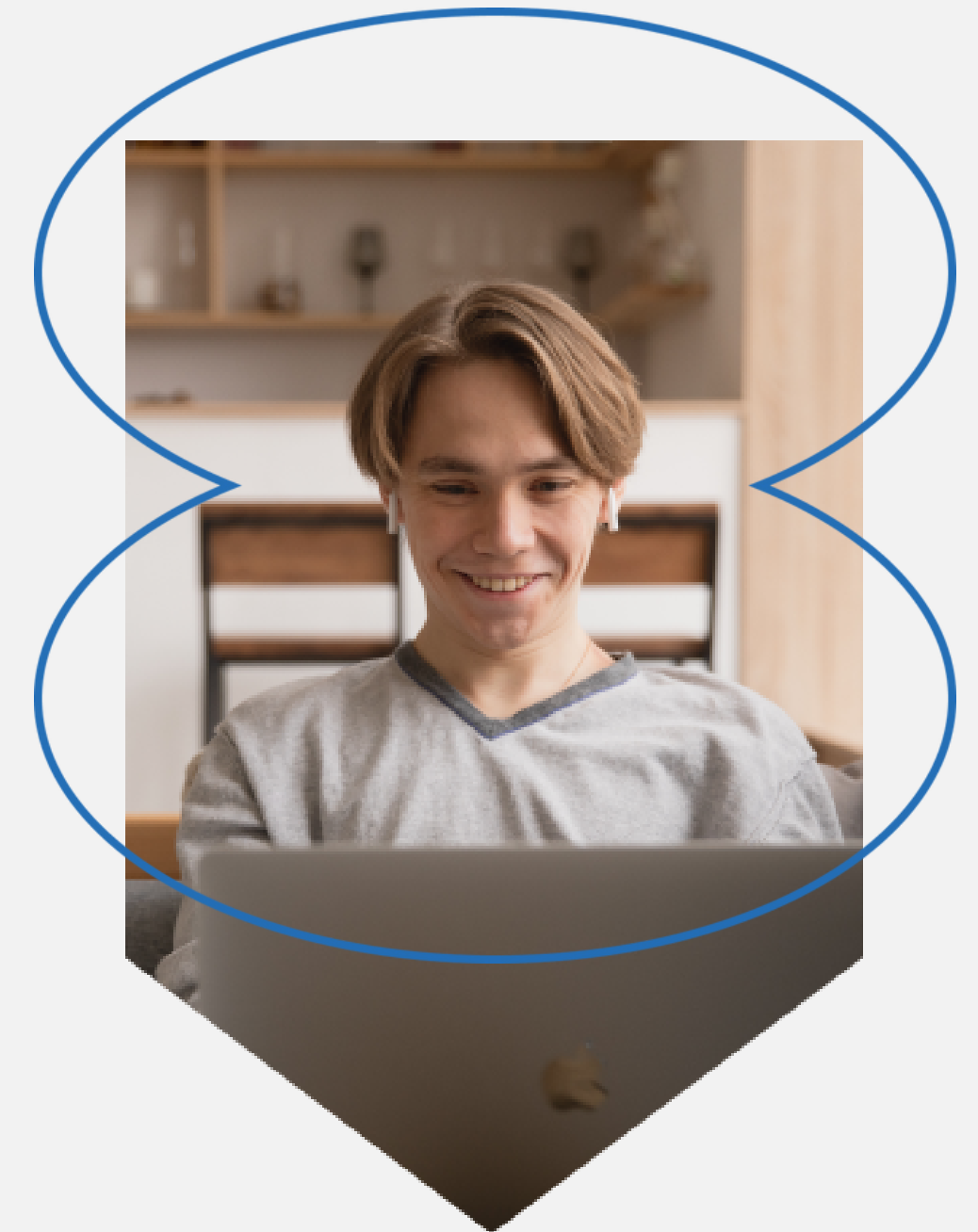
IB Environmental Systems and Societies aims to develop students' understanding of environmental challenges through an interdisciplinary approach that combines science and social perspectives.

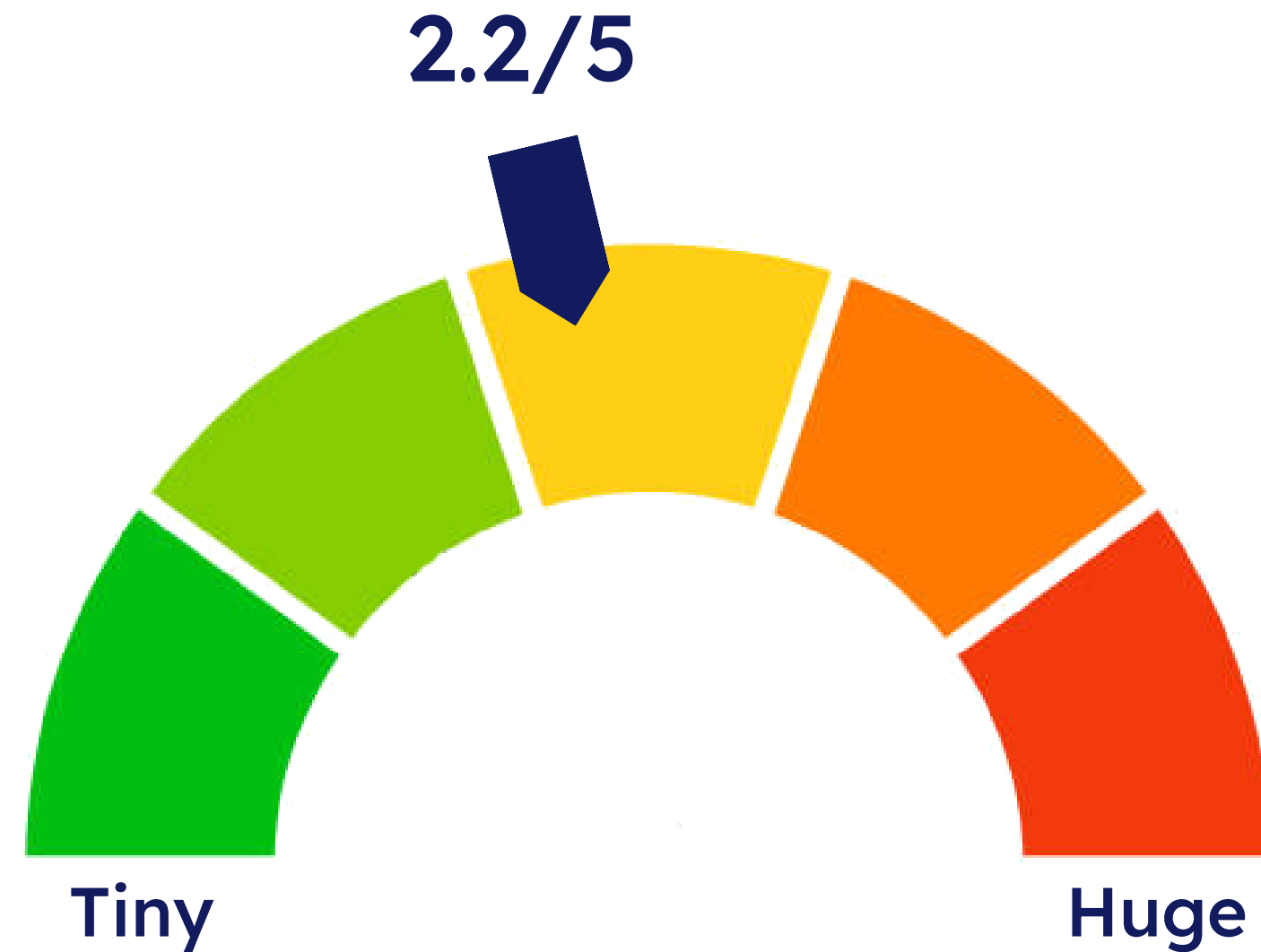

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HOW BIG IS THE JUMP FROM SL → HL

The transition from SL to HL in ESS is relatively small, rated 2.2 out of 5.

HL involves more depth in research and data analysis, but the overall increase in difficulty is manageable with consistent study.

ASSESSMENT STRUCTURE

PAPER 1

External

Students will be provided with data in a variety of forms relating to a specific, previously unseen case study.

Questions will be based on the analysis and evaluation of the data in the case study.

SL: 1 hour, 25% final grade
HL: 2 hours, 30% final grade

PAPER 2

External — 50% final grade

Section A is made up of short-answer and data-based questions.

Section B requires students to answer structured essay questions. There is a limited amount of choice.

SL: 2 hours
HL: 2 hours 30 mins

INTERNAL ASSESSMENT (IA)

Internal

The individual investigation is an open-ended task where students gather and analyze data to answer their own research question. The result is a written report, with a maximum word count of 3,000 words.

SL: 25% final grade
HL: 20% final grade

TRICKS FOR YOUR PAPER 1

Do's

- **READ THE DATA CAREFULLY** – Pay attention to trends, scales, and patterns in the case study. The answers are often in the provided information.
- **SUPPORT ANSWERS WITH SPECIFIC EVIDENCE** – Use figures, trends, or examples from the case study to justify your points.
- **PRACTICE TIME MANAGEMENT** – Allocate time wisely; don't get stuck on one question.
- **USE ESS TERMINOLOGY** – Incorporate key terms like “sustainability,” “systems approach,” and “ecological footprint” to show subject knowledge.

Don'ts

- **DON'T MAKE ASSUMPTIONS** – Base answers on the provided case study, not general knowledge.
- **DON'T IGNORE THE QUESTION COMMAND TERMS** – Pay attention to words like “describe,” “evaluate,” and “compare.”
- **DON'T WRITE VAGUE ANSWERS** – Be precise in your explanations and use real-world examples when applicable.
- **DON'T FORGET TO JUSTIFY RECOMMENDATIONS** – If asked for a solution, explain why it would work.

TRICKS FOR YOUR PAPER 2

Do's

- LOOK AT THE MARKS ALLOCATION – More marks mean more detailed explanations and examples.
- PLAN ESSAY-STYLE QUESTIONS BEFORE WRITING – Use a brief outline to structure your response.
- USE DIAGRAMS WHERE RELEVANT – A well-labeled diagram can save time and improve clarity.
- USE EXAMPLES – Relate answers to real-world environmental case studies to strengthen arguments.

Don'ts

- DON'T OVERWRITE SHORT-ANSWER QUESTIONS – Keep it concise and stick to the point.
- DON'T IGNORE COUNTERARGUMENTS – If the question asks for evaluation, discuss both sides.
- DON'T FORGET TO LINK TO KEY CONCEPTS – Always connect responses back to perspectives, systems, and sustainability.
- DON'T WRITE GENERIC RESPONSES – Use ESS-specific terms and concepts to show deep understanding.



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HOW TO ACE YOUR IA

PERSONAL ENGAGEMENT

Relate your research to personal or local experiences, and choose a unique research question that reflects your genuine interest.

Avoid generic topics—make it personal and creative to stand out.

CRAFT A STRONG RESEARCH QUESTION

Research common IA topics for inspiration, then adapt one to match your personal interests. A focused question with clear, measurable variables will make your investigation unique and engaging.

COLLECT 1ST HAND (QUALITY) DATA

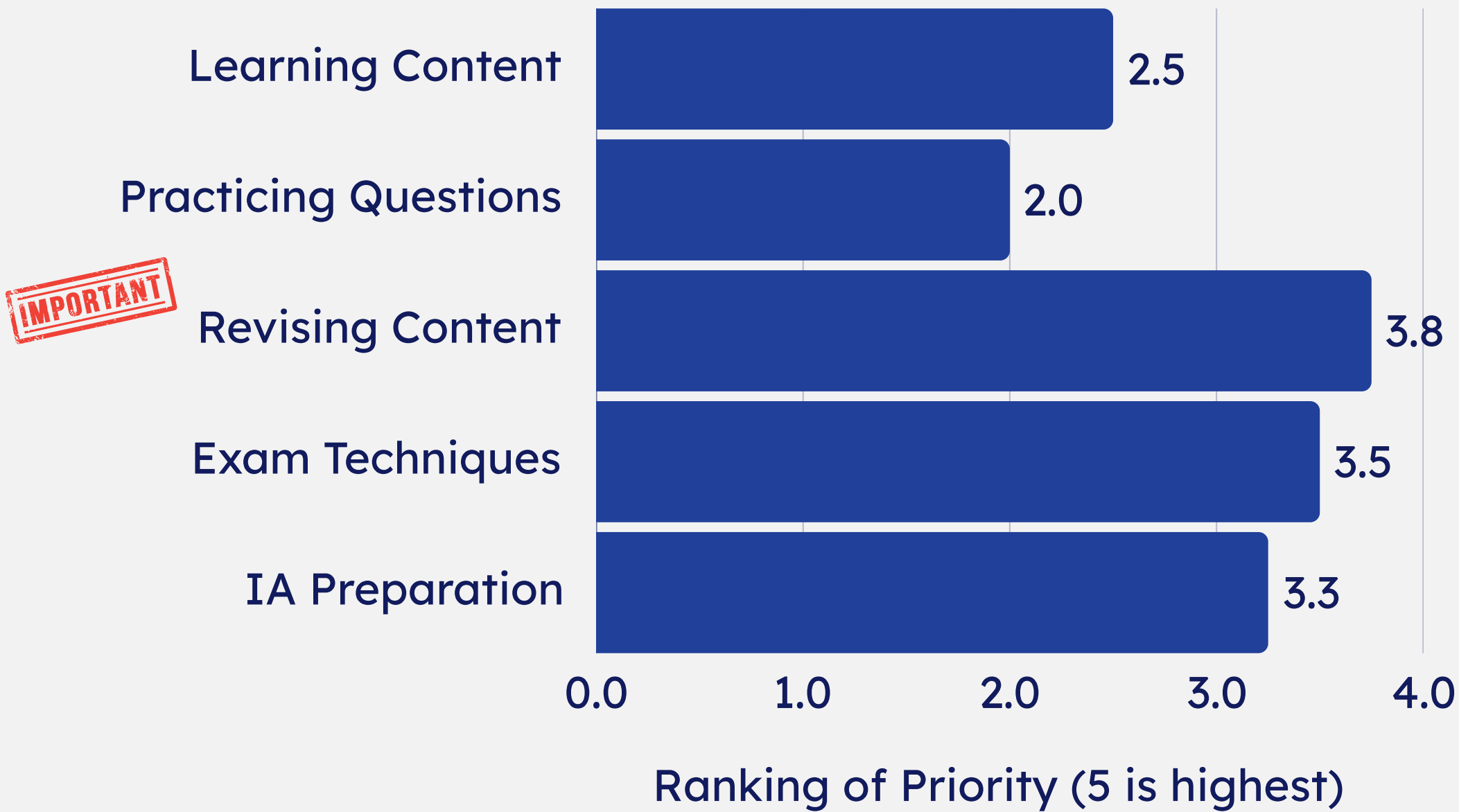
Aim for at least 25 data points by conducting five trials for five different values of your independent variable. Accurate, repeatable data is key to producing reliable and high-scoring results.

HAVE A DELIVERABLE CONCLUSION

Your conclusion should answer your research question and address your hypothesis. Clearly state whether your hypothesis was supported, explain your findings, and suggest improvements for accuracy and reliability in future experiments.



EFFECTIVE STUDY STRATEGIES



WHAT SHOULD YOU PRIORITIZE IN YOUR STUDY TIME?

Based on tutor insights, revising content and improving exam techniques are key priorities for success in ESS. 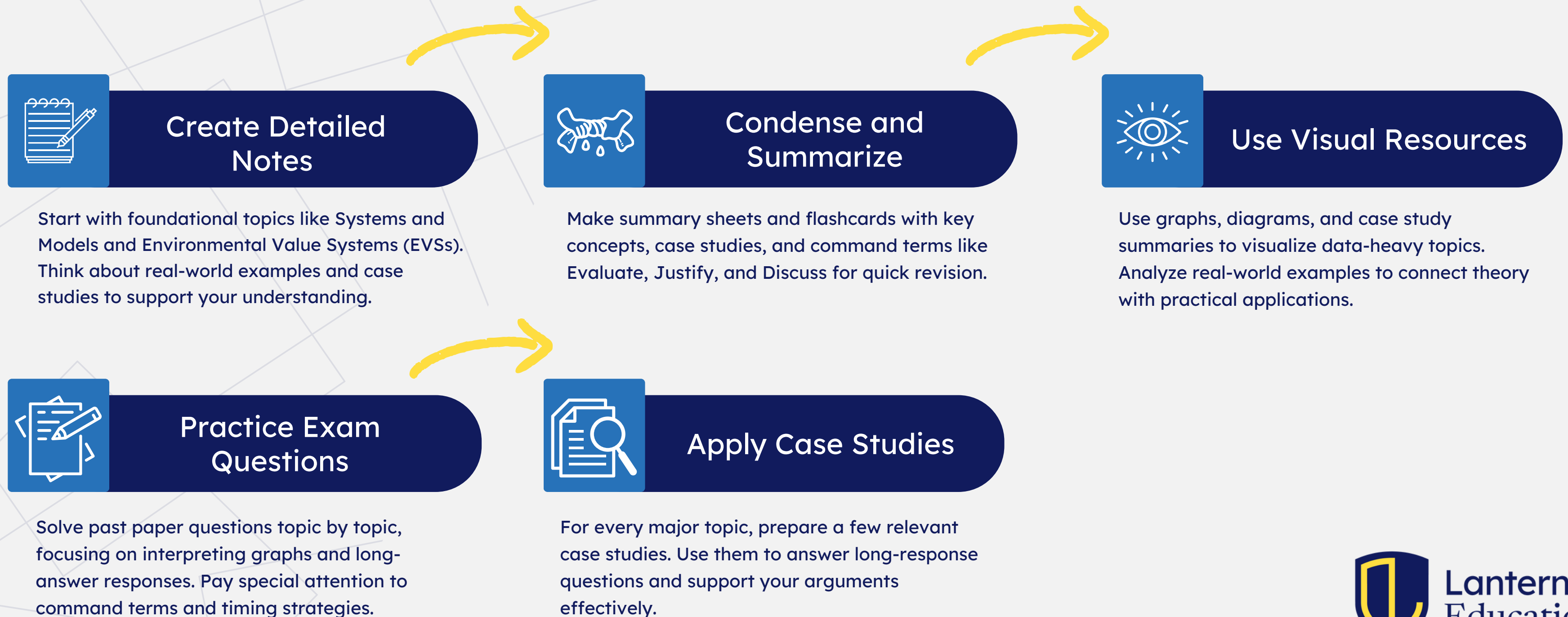
THE 3-STEP REVISION STRATEGY



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1. UNDERSTAND THE CONTENT

The key to success in ESS is mastering core concepts and applying them to real-world situations. Focus on building a strong foundation and integrating case studies to strengthen your answers.



STRUGGLING WITH CONTENT?

2. MASTER EXAM TECHNIQUES



Understand Command Terms

The most effective way to memorize. Test yourself regularly on key concepts without looking at your notes.

Use apps like Anki or Quizlet to quiz yourself on processes and definitions



Analyze Data and Graphs

Learn how to interpret statistical data, trends, and graphs, which are common in IB exams.



Memorize Case Studies

Prepare several case studies for each topic to use as examples in long-answer questions.



Teach Someone Else

Teaching forces you to explain concepts clearly and identify areas where you lack understanding.

Pro Tip: Even talking out loud to yourself works!



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3. PRACTICE, PRACTICE, PRACTICE!



The most important part of your revision is practice. 80% of your entire grade comes down to just a few hours of exams, so mastering how to answer questions is key. Think of exams like video game levels—repeat them enough, and they’ll become second nature. The more past papers you practice, the more confident and efficient you’ll be.

LEARN IB’S “CRYPTIC” LANGUAGE

This is where the markscheme is your best friend. It shows you exactly what the examiners expect in each answer. If you train yourself to write responses based on the markscheme, you’ll know precisely how to get full marks every time. 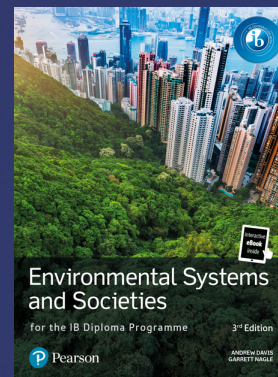

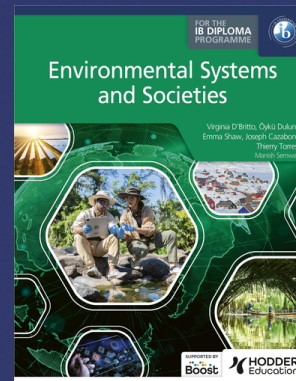
